

An emergency meeting of the Nebraska Public Service Commission was convened in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln. The purpose of the meeting was to have the Commission act on a rate application filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc., d/b/a Prince of the Road, and their request for emergency relief.

The need for the meeting is to take immediate action to avoid significant monetary damage to the Applicant if the application was not approved on an emergency basis.

The meeting was conducted with Commissioners Rod Johnson, Tim Schram, Jerry Vap, Anne Boyle and Frank Landis present in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln. Also present in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, were Mark Breiner, Director, Transportation Department, Mike Hybl, Executive Director and Deena Ackerman, Administrative Assistant.

Chairman Johnson called the emergency meeting to order at 2:30 p.m. He announced that Commission meetings are conducted in accordance with the Nebraska Open Meetings Act and all participants were free to make comments.

Commissioner Johnson informed the Commission that the Omaha World Herald, Lincoln Journal Star, Associated Press and Kearney Hub were notified of the emergency meeting on July 11, 2012, between 1:20 and 1:40 p.m.

Mr. Breiner summarized the reason for the emergency meeting and answered questions of the Commissioners. After discussion, Commissioner Jerry Vap moved to enter an Order to grant rate increase on an emergency basis and Commissioner Tim Schram seconded the motion. Motion passed with Commissioners Rod Johnson, Anne Boyle, Frank Landis, Tim Schram and Jerry Vap voting AYE.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:35 p.m.
