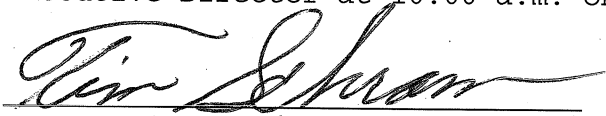
GENERAL ADMINISTRATION

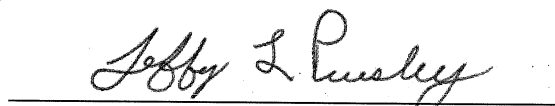
Chairman Schram invited the public to address the Commission. No public comments were received.
