SOUTHEAST REGION 911 OUTAGE REPAIRED

LINCOLN, AUGUST 8, 2018 – The Nebraska Public Service Commission (PSC) has been notified all 911 Centers in the Southeast Region are now capable of receiving 911 calls.

The outage which was reported in the early morning hours of August 8, affected several counties in the Southeast Region. The Southeast Region is comprised of 15 counties to include Cass, Clay, Fillmore, Gage, Jefferson, Johnson, Lancaster, Nemaha, Nuckolls, Pawnee, Richardson, Seward, Thayer and York Counties.

Counties were affected in various ways with some not having any issues and others experiencing difficulties.

Seven counties in the Southeast Region provided citizens an alternate number to call during the outage. They include, Gage, Jefferson, Johnson, Nemaha, Otoe, Pawnee and Seward Counties.

The PSC continues to work with the Southeast Region and its provider Windstream to determine the exact cause of the outage. ###
