

OP-0003 Keystone XL Pipeline Application Public Meetings

(May 23, 2017)- The Public Service Commission has issued an Application [Event Timeline](#) and a [News Release](#) (dated May 23) both found on the [KXL Pipeline Information](#) page of the PSC website concerning the Commission's intent to hold public meetings to gather public comment on the Keystone XL Pipeline Application.

The second public meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, June 7, at the O'Neill Community Center, in O'Neill.

The Commission is considering other locations along the proposed pipeline route and will announce additional meetings as they are scheduled.

Public Meetings

Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 57-1407(2), the Commission may hold public meetings for the purpose of receiving input from the public. The dates, times, and locations, of any public meetings have yet to be determined and will be announced closer to the date of the meeting. Public input received at the public meetings shall be limited as directed by the Siting Act. Any comments received will be made a part of the permanent record of this proceeding.
