

AFFIDAVIT OF MR. VICTOR HOWARD



Mr. Victor Howard, Vice President, Retail-Choice, Continuum Retail Energy Services, LLC, (“Continuum”), previously known as Seminole Energy Services, LLC (“Seminole”), with offices located at 1414 Louisiana, Suite 4200, Houston, TX 77002, being first duly sworn on oath, states as follows:

Continuum holds a certificate as a competitive natural gas provider (CNGP) within the state of Nebraska since June 24, 2008. The certificate was originally granted to Post Rock Gas, LLC (Post Rock) on February 3, 2004 in accordance with the *Nebraska Revised Statutes*, Sections 66-1848 -- 66-1849 (2003 Supp.), and 291 *Nebraska Administrative Code*, Chapter 9, Rule 009. Subsequently on March 28, 2007, the Nebraska Public Service Commission granted the request of a name change from Post Rock (a Seminole affiliate) to Seminole High Plains, LLC (Seminole High Plains). However, to meet tightened Federal Energy Regulatory Commission

regulations, Seminole replaced its affiliate Seminole High Plains as the CNGP certificate holder in Nebraska. With the name change from Seminole to Continuum on June 12, 2014, the CNGP certificate transferred to Continuum.

2015 CNGP Yearly Revenue Report

Pursuant to Rule 009, the CNGP certificate holder, Continuum must file a yearly revenue report “stating the total annual dekatherms delivered and sold to residential customers within each utility rate area” in the year July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015.

The CNGP certificate holder must also state “the total revenues associated with the sale of natural gas to all jurisdictional customers within each utility rate area in such year.”

In compliance with Rule 009, Continuum states that it delivered and sold 1,268,489 dekatherms to residential customers within each Nebraska utility rate area in the year July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015. Further, Continuum states that it received \$9,095,681 in revenues associated with the sale of natural gas to all jurisdictional customers within each utility rate area in the year July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015.

Further during this reporting period, Continuum states that no business was conducted under the Post Rock or Seminole names; therefore there are no dekatherms delivered and sold and no revenues to report.


In conclusion, Continuum states that it received \$9,095,681 in total revenues associated with the sale of natural gas to all jurisdictional customers within each utility rate area in the year July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015. These numbers are based on an allocation of total sales. Continuum serves some residential customers located behind non-jurisdictional, multi-use meters and has allocated accordingly.
