RE: Comments regarding Address Point Layers Application No. 911-057/PI-187

In the course of meetings with the City of North Platte and Lincoln County on GIS matters, our 911 Center realized we could benefit greatly from an Address Point Layer. We currently utilize centerline data with a range....and while it has served well enough; we feel the address point layer will serve more accurately. We have a large county, approximately 2,575 square miles, and we feel anything that can be done to more accurately identify addresses will be a great benefit. Since our 911 center is the chief beneficiary of this accurate data....it seems logical that the Wireless Funds would be an appropriate way to fund the expense of this data creation. I believe the ongoing maintenance should be addressed as well. We have received an estimate of \$15,000 for the preparation of an address point layer for Lincoln County, and would incur yearly maintenance costs as well.
