

Section 2 – Project Descriptions

Project 1

Arapahoe Telephone Company, hereafter referred to as ATC, proposes to add Broadband data services in the **unserved** portion of its certificated exchange area of Loomis, NE. ATC currently provides voice services in this area and proposes to add Broadband data capability to the **unserved** portions of the Loomis Exchange via construction of fiber-fed DSL network equipment.

The system as proposed is capable of providing data services at speed of up to 20 Mbps downstream and 2 Mbps upstream. These speeds exceed Commission’s minimum speed standards of 4 Mbps downstream and 1 Mbps upstream.

Project 2

ATCJET.NET, a wholly owned subsidiary of ATC proposes to upgrade its Broadband data service capability in the **underserved** rural Elwood areas in Gosper and Dawson Counties. ATCJET.NET currently provides wireless Internet in this area at speed that does not meet the Commission’s definition of Broadband service. ATCJET.NET proposes to upgrade this Broadband data capability to the **underserved** rural portions of these counties via replacement of its existing wireless Broadband distribution and backhaul microwave network equipment.

The system as proposed is capable of providing data services at speeds of up to 12 Mbps downstream and 1 Mbps upstream. These speeds exceed the Commission’s minimum speed standards of 4 Mbps downstream and 1 Mbps upstream.
