

NEBRASKA BROADBAND PILOT PROGRAM

APPLICATION OF CENTURYLINK, INC.
Project: Kimball Highway 71 and County Road 14

1. A listing of all companies associated with the proposed broadband project.

2. A description of the proposed broadband project plan.

This project would provide broadband service at 4 Mbps download and 1 Mbps upload to approximately 13 homes along around Highway 71 and County Road 14 near Kimball. The area is in the Kimball exchange.

3. A description of which areas are "unserved" or "underserved."

Based on the end-of-year 2011 data from the National Telecommunications and Information Administration, the proposed project area encompasses some areas that are currently unserved and some areas that are currently served by broadband service at varying speeds.

Portions of Census Blocks 1401, 1347, 1327, 1344, and 1406 are currently unserved and will be able to receive service at speeds of 4 Mbps download and 1 Mbps upload once this project is completed. This project will also provide broadband service at speeds of 4 Mbps download and 1 Mbps upload to all of Census Blocks 1338 and 1330 and portions of Census Blocks 1347, 1327, and 1344, which currently have broadband service available, but at speeds less than 3 Mbps download. In addition, due to the way broadband service must be deployed, Census Blocks 1346, 1345, 1350, 1405, 1407 and 1424 and portions of Census Blocks 1344, 1406, and 1401 will also be able to receive broadband service from CenturyLink at speeds up to 4 Mbps download and 1 Mbps upload. These areas currently have access to broadband service at varying speeds greater than 3 Mbps download.

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4. An electronic map.

5. An estimate of the number of potential new broadband subscribers.

This project will provide broadband service to approximately 13 living units.

6. A schedule for broadband deployment.

CenturyLink intends to complete the buildout and deployment of broadband within 24 months of receiving NUSF-77 funding approval. Within 6 months of approval of the application, CenturyLink will complete the planning and engineering for this project. Within 6 months of the completion of the planning and engineering, CenturyLink will complete the placement of the cable needed for this project. Within 6 months of the cable placement, the equipment will be placed. Finally, within 6 months of the equipment placement, CenturyLink will test the newly placed facilities and turn up service.

7. A proposed budget.

8. Proposed retail pricing.

The retail pricing for the proposed project area will be the same as the retail pricing for broadband services in CenturyLink's service territory in Nebraska. The pricing will vary depending on the speed the subscriber chooses. The monthly recurring price for CenturyLink's broadband service is as follows:

CenturyLink High Speed Internet service requires the customer to also subscribe to voice service. Pure broadband does not require voice service.

If the customer chooses to lease a modem from CenturyLink, the monthly recurring cost would be \$8.00 per month.

A number of nonrecurring charges may apply to the customer:

Activation (broadband only)	\$19.95
Standard Installation (1 computer)	\$49.95
Standard Installation (2-5 computers)	\$99.95

CenturyLink reserves the right to adjust the retail pricing for broadband services.

9. The applicant's commitment to offer broadband services within the project service area for a minimum of five years.

CenturyLink commits that it will offer broadband service to the customers in the Highway 71 and County Road 14 area near Kimball for a minimum of 5 years.

10. The applicant's commitment to provide broadband data to the Commission.

CenturyLink commits that it will provide broadband data to the Commission and its vendors for the duration of the State Broadband Data and Development program for the Highway 71 and County Road 14 area near Kimball.

11. The applicant's financial qualifications.

CenturyLink files an Annual Report Form M with the Nebraska Commission. This report details CenturyLink's financial qualifications.


- 13. The applicant's financial match.**
