

limits of Stanton with plans to provide video to customers outside the city limits in the near future. We began providing internet service in 1996 and started with dial-up modem service and are currently providing high speed broadband to customers in the Stanton area on fiber optic cable. We also provide computer sales and repair service to the Stanton area.

Q. What is the purpose of your testimony?

A. My testimony is provided to support the application filed by Stanton CATV for funding from the Nebraska Universal Service Fund Broadband Program (“Application”). The Application is incorporated in my testimony by reference.

Q. Can you please generally describe the Application?

A. The project will provide voice and broadband capability to the proposed funded service area by constructing a WiMAX standard, fixed wireless broadband distribution system utilizing 3.65 GHz wireless spectrum. The system as designed is capable of providing services up to 10 Mbps downstream and 5 Mbps upstream. The project will provide service to the rural areas south of Pilger, Nebraska and east of Stanton, Nebraska.

Q. Are there additional details and supporting information in the Application?

A. Yes. These details and supporting information are contained in the Applications filed with the Commission. Additionally, Staff requested and was provided additional information to supplement the data provided in the Application.

Q. Do you support the Staff recommendation regarding the Application?

A. Yes. I appreciate the Staff’s recommendation to approve the Application and I believe that the Commission should adopt the Staff’s recommendation regarding the Application.

Q. Does this conclude your testimony?

A. Yes, it does.
