

2                   **REPLY TESTIMONY OF ANN PROCKISH**

5   **Q.    Please state your name, title, and business address.**

6    A.    My name is Ann Prockish. I am employed by CenturyLink as Director – State  
7           Regulatory Operations. My business address is 100 CenturyLink Drive, Monroe,  
8           Louisiana 71203.

9   **Q.    Are you the same Ann Prockish that filed direct testimony in this**  
10       **proceeding?**

11   A.    Yes, I am.

12   **Q.    What is the purpose of your reply testimony?**

13   A.    I am responding to the testimony filed by Mr. Joe Jetensky of Huntel CableVision,  
14       Inc. d/b/a Huntel Communications (“Huntel”) challenging CenturyLink’s  
15       application for NUSF-92 support for the project in Wakefield.

16   **Q.    What is the basis for Huntel’s challenge?**

17   A.    Mr. Jetensky states that Huntel already provides broadband service at speeds in  
18       excess of 4 Mbps download and 1 Mbps upload to 30 census blocks in and around  
19       Wakefield.

20   **Q.    How many census blocks are impacted by CenturyLink’s Wakefield project?**

21   A.    If the Commission were to approve CenturyLink’s application, CenturyLink  
22       would deploy broadband service to 118 census blocks, including the 30 that  
23       Huntel cites in its challenge.

1 **Q. How many households are able to receive service from Huntel?**

2 A. CenturyLink has determined that there are 128 households in the 30 census blocks  
3 where Huntel says it is already providing service. However, there are another 180  
4 households in the 88 remaining census blocks that currently cannot receive  
5 broadband service, or that can receive broadband service but at speeds less than 4  
6 Mbps download and 1 Mbps upload. Should the Commission choose not to  
7 approve this project, these 180 households would continue to be without  
8 broadband service, or continue to receive service at inferior speeds, for the  
9 foreseeable future.

10 **Q. Is it possible to deploy broadband service to just the 180 households that are**  
11 **outside the Huntel service territory?**

12 A. No. The vast majority of the costs associated with this project are associated with  
13 circuit equipment, such as the equipment to upgrade the device that would allow  
14 CenturyLink to provide high speed internet service. That upgrade will benefit all  
15 households that are served by that device and it is not possible target the  
16 equipment and the investment to just those households that currently do not have  
17 access to broadband from another provider.


18 **Q. Does this conclude your testimony?**
