- 2) Do you approve or disapprove of the job Congress is doing? If you approve, press 1. If you disapprove, press 2. If you're not sure, press 3.
- 3) Do you approve or disapprove of the job Republican Speaker of the House Paul Ryan is doing? If you approve, press 1. If you disapprove, press 2. If you're not sure, press 3.
- 4) Do you approve or disapprove of the job Democratic House Minority Leader Nancy Pelosi is doing? If you approve, press 1. If you disapprove, press 2. If you're not sure, press 3.
- 5) Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of **Brad Ashford** ? If favorable, press 1. If unfavorable, press 2. If you're not sure, press 3.
- 6) Do you approve or disapprove of the job your **Congressman, Don Bacon**, is doing? If you approve, press 1. If you disapprove, press 2. If you're not sure, press 3.
- 7) If the election for Congress were held today, and the candidates were Democrat **Brad Ashford** and Republican **Don Bacon**, who would you vote for? If you'd vote for **Brad Ashford** , press 1. If you'd vote for **Don Bacon**, press 2. If you're not sure, press 3.
- 8) In the election for President, did you vote for Republican Donald Trump, Democrat Hillary Clinton, or someone else or did you not vote in the election? If you voted for Donald Trump, press 1. If Hillary Clinton, press 2. If you voted for someone else or did not vote in the election, press 3.
- 9) If you are a woman, press 1. If a man, press 2.
- 10) If you are a Democrat, press 1. If a Republican, press 2. If an independent, press 3.
- 11) If you are Hispanic or Latino, press 1. If white, press 2. If African-American, press 3. If other, press 4.
- 12) If you are 18-29 years old, press 1. If 30-45, press 2. If 46-65, press 3. If older than 65, press 4.
- 13) Based on what you know right now, would you say you support or oppose the Republicans in Congress' tax proposal, or have you not heard anything about it? If you support the Republicans in Congress' tax proposal, press 1. If you oppose it, press 2. If you haven't heard anything about it, press 3.
- 14) Let me tell you a few things the Republicans have proposed as part of their tax plan. After each one, please tell me if you support or oppose that provision. First: it cuts the top corporate tax rate from 35% to 20%, and corporations get even more favorable treatment of income earned overseas, which is taxed even less. If you support cutting the top corporate tax rate from 35% to 20% and taxing income that's earned overseas even less, press 1. If you oppose that, press 2. If you're not sure, press 3.

- 15) Here's the next one: over 80% of the tax cuts go to the top 1% -- those with incomes of over \$430,000 a year. If you support over 80% of the tax cuts going to the top 1%, press 1. If you oppose that, press 2. If you're not sure, press 3.
- 16) Here's the next one: it eliminates the state and local income and local sales tax deduction and reduces the property tax deduction. If you support eliminating the state and local income and local sales tax deduction and reducing the property tax deduction, press 1. If you oppose that, press 2. If you're not sure, press 3.
- 17) Here's the next one: the tax plan would increase the deficit by \$1.5 trillion over the next ten years. If you support increasing the deficit by \$1.5 trillion over the next ten years, press 1. If you oppose that, press 2. If you're not sure, press 3.
- 18) Would you be less likely or more likely to support the Republican tax plan if you knew that Donald Trump and his family were going to personally profit from the changes in the tax code, or would it not make a difference? If you'd be less likely to support the Republican tax plan if you knew that Donald Trump and his family were going to personally profit from the changes in the tax code, press 1. If you'd be more likely to support it, press 2. If it wouldn't make a difference, press 3. If you're not sure, press 4.
- 19) If your **Congressman Don Bacon** voted for the Republican tax plan, would that make you less likely or more likely to vote for **him** next time, or would it not make a difference? If it would make you less likely to vote for **him**, press 1. If more likely, press 2. If it wouldn't make a difference, press 3. If you're not sure, press 4.
