### 1. Taxpayer Funding ☰

### 2. If undecided ☰

If you had to decide today press 1 if you support taxpayer funding of abortion. If you oppose taxpayer funding of abortion press 2. if you are still unsure press 3

If you believe senators do not have a duty to vote on the budget press 2. If you are unsure press 3

For Has Duty, press 1  
For Does not have Duty, press 2  
For Unsure, press 3

### 4. More Like Washington ☰

News reports say this is the first time in memory that Nebraska lawmakers were prevented from voting on the state budget by a minority of its members. On a 1-5 scale, with 1 being not at all concerned and 5 being very concerned, how concerned are you that partisan politics is making our Unicameral Legislature less effective and more like Washington, DC?

For Not that concerned, press 2  
For Unsure, press 3  
For Somewhat concerned, press 4  
For Very concernd, press 5
