The proposed construction, operation, and maintenance shall not begin until sixty (60) days from the date notice was received by all parties listed below, unless signed Waiving Rights to Object Forms are received by the Commission.				
The notice and applicable attachments are to be mailed to the Commission via certified mail and to all persons and corporations which own or operate electrical, communication, or railroad signal lines located within the respective distances listed in the matrix below.
