AFTER DUE INVESTIGATION, it is hereby certified that the above-named carrier has complied with all applicable provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat., Sections 75-301 to 75-322.04, (Reissue 2003), and the requirements, rules and regulations prescribed thereunder and, therefore, is entitled to receive authority from the Nebraska Public Service Commission to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a motor carrier.

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Household goods between points in and within a 15-mile radius of Omaha over irregular routes. A) Household goods between points within a 15-mile radius of LaPlatte, and between points within said radial area on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. (B) Household goods between points in Cass, Dodge, Douglas, Gage, Lancaster, Otoe, Saunders, Sarpy, and Washington counties over irregular routes. © Household goods between points in Butler, Jefferson, Saline, and Seward counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes.
