

CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

AFTER DUE INVESTIGATION, it is hereby certified that the above-named carrier has complied with all applicable provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat, Sections 75-301 to 75-322.04, (Reissue 1996), and the requirements, rules and regulations prescribed thereunder and, therefore, is entitled to receive authority from the Nebraska Public Service Commission to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a motor carrier.

IT IS CERTIFIED, that pursuant to the Commission's Order the said carrier be, and it is hereby, issued this Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as evidence of the authority of the holder to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a common carrier by motor vehicle; subject, however, to such terms, conditions and limitations as are now, or may hereafter be, attached to the exercise of the privileges granted to the said carrier.

(A) Indian Health Service clients by van between points in Nebraska over irregular routes under continuing contract(s) with Indian Health Service, and for (B) passengers and their baggage by van between points in Nebraska over irregular routes under continuing contract(s) with the Nebraska Department of Social Services.
