

CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

AFTER DUE INVESTIGATION, it is hereby certified that the above-named carrier has complied with all applicable provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat., Sections 75-301 to 75-322.04, (Reissue 1996), and the requirements, rules and regulations prescribed thereunder and, therefore, is entitled to receive authority from the Nebraska Public Service Commission to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a motor carrier.

IT IS CERTIFIED, that pursuant to the Commission's Order the said carrier be, and it is hereby, issued this Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as evidence of the authority of the holder to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a common carrier by motor vehicle; subject, however, to such terms, conditions and limitations as are now, or may hereafter be, attached to the exercise of the privileges granted to the said carrier.

AND IT IS FURTHER CERTIFIED, that the transportation service to be performed by the said carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce shall be as specified below:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED: COMMON: Transportation of passengers in open class service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes in sedans, vans, and station wagons. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. The transportation of passengers and their baggage point-to-point in Lancaster County is not authorized. The transportation services of passengers and their baggage originating within Lancaster County is not authorized. The transportation services of passengers and their baggage by sedan or station wagon originating from or point-to-point within any territory where a taxicab company holds a certificate or permit is not authorized. RESERVATION: The Commission expressly reserves the right to further restrict this authority with respect to sedans and station wagons, on its own motion or the motion of another, in the event that a carrier which, meets all the requirements of Article 75, Chapter 3 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes and all applicable Commission rules and regulations thereunder, offers taxi services in territories unserved as of November 26, 2002.

SUPPLEMENT 1

Transportation of passengers and their baggage by limousine between points in Jefferson, Gage, Pawnee, and Johnson counties, and between points in said counties on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. Passengers and their baggage by luxury limousines between points in Lancaster County. Passengers and their baggage by luxury limousines between points in Douglas County. RESTRICTIONS: Transportation of passengers which is not arranged 24 hours or more in advance of the time service is provided is not authorized. Passengers and their baggage by limousine between points in York, Saline, Thayer, Fillmore, Seward, Lancaster and Douglas counties, and between points in said counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.
