On May 24, 2022, the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") opened the above-captioned docket to investigate whether jurisdictional utilities should add a tariff provision addressing customer requests for voluntary removal or relocation of natural gas facilities. A Petition for Formal Intervention was filed by the Nebraska Public Advocate on June 1, 2022.


Pursuant to the Rules of Commission Procedure, 291 Neb. Admin. Code § 1-015.01 et seq., I find that the above-listed petition for formal intervention should be granted, and the Nebraska Public Advocate should be designated as a formal intervenor and a party to this proceeding. The Nebraska Public Advocate further should be entitled to participate in this proceeding to the extent of his express interest in the matter and in a manner consistent with 291 Neb. Admin. Code § 1-015.01C.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Hearing Officer that the petition of the Public Advocate for formal intervention in this matter should be granted consistent with the terms set forth herein.
