BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On May 1, 2025, Black Hills Nebraska Gas, LLC, d/b/a Black Hills Energy filed an application with the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") seeking a general rate increase. A petition for Formal Intervention was filed by the Nebraska Public Advocate on May 6, 2025, and by the Federal Executive Agencies on May 30, 2025. These petitions were approved by the Commission on May 8, 2025, and June 3, 2025, respectively. On June 5, 2025, WoodRiver Energy, LLC ("WoodRiver") filed a petition for Formal Intervention in this matter.

Pursuant to the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Public Service Commission, I find that the above-described petition for formal intervention should be granted, and WoodRiver should be designated as a formal intervenor and a party to this proceeding. Furthermore, WoodRiver should be entitled to participate in this proceeding to the extent of its express interest in the matter and in a manner consistent with Commission Rules.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Hearing Officer that the petition of WoodRiver Energy, LLC for formal intervention in this matter should be granted consistent with the terms set forth herein.
