#### BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On May 1, 2025, Black Hills Nebraska Gas, LLC, d/b/a Black Hills Energy ("Black Hills") filed an application with the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") seeking a general rate increase. Petitions for Formal Intervention were filed by the Nebraska Public Advocate on May 6, 2025, the Federal Executive Agencies on May 30, 2025, and WoodRiver Energy, LLC on June 6, 2025. These petitions were approved by the Commission on May 8, 2025, June 3, 2025, and June 6, 2025, respectively.

## **Procedural Schedule**

A planning conference was held on June 10, 2025. Douglas Law was present on behalf of Black Hills. Chris Dibbern, the Public Advocate, was present. Major Leslie R Newton was present on behalf of the Federal Executive Agencies and Alex Goldberg was present on behalf of WoodRiver Energy, LLC. Pursuant to the planning conference, a procedural schedule was discussed and is set forth below.

The schedule set forth in this order allows the Commission to enter a final order in this proceeding within 240 days from the date of filing. In constructing this schedule, the Commission is not making a final interpretation of the time period allowed under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 66-1838. The Commission adopts this timeframe only in recognition of the different possible interpretations of this statute.<sup>1</sup>

#### A. Service

# B. Discovery

Should this order conflict with any provision of said Rules, this order controls. Parties should make efforts to resolve any discovery disputes.

All parties shall provide a courtesy copy of any discovery requests and responses to the Commission. Such discovery requests and responses shall not be part of the official record unless they are offered and accepted as exhibits during the hearing on the application.
