BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On May 1, 2025, Black Hills Nebraska Gas, LLC, d/b/a Black Hills Energy filed an application with the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") seeking a general rate increase. The Federal Executive Agencies ("FEA") filed a petition to intervene and for admission pro hac vice on May 30, 2025. A hearing officer order approved that petition for intervention and pro hac vice admission on June 3, 2025.

On June 16, 2025, the FEA filed a motion to withdraw from this docket and terminate FEA's status as a party to the proceedings. The motion stated that FEA has determined that it is not cost effective to continue their intervention in the matter.

Upon review of the facts presented and all applicable statutes and regulations, the Commission finds that FEA's motion to withdraw their intervention should be granted, and that the FEA shall no longer be a party in this matter.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Hearing Officer that the motion of the Federal Executive Agencies to withdraw their intervention in this matter should be granted.
