AFTER DUE INVESTIGATION, it is hereby certified that the above-named carrier has complied with all applicable provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. sections 75-301 to 75-322 and the requirements, rules and regulations prescribed thereunder and, therefore, is entitled to receive authority from the Nebraska Public Service Commission to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a motor carrier.

IT IS CERTIFIED that pursuant to the Commission's Order, the said carrier be, and is hereby, issued this Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as evidence of the authority of the holder to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a common carrier by motor vehicle; subject, however, to such terms, conditions and limitations as are now, or may hereafter be, attached to the exercise of the privileges granted to said carrier.

AND IT IS FURTHER CERTIFIED that the transportation service to be performed by the said carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce shall be as specified below:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Transportation of passengers by van, sedan, and SUV in open class service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. HHS Designation: yes.

RESTRICTIONS: the operation of no more than three vehicles in service at any given time. The transportation of passengers and their baggage originating from, or point-to-point within Adams, Buffalo, Hall, and Lincoln counties is not authorized.

SUPPLEMENT 1: Applicant shall be permitted to operate an additional three vehicles for the transportation of passengers and their baggage point-to-point within Douglas and Sarpy counties. Nothing in these restrictions shall restrict the number of vehicles Applicant utilizes for the purpose of providing transportation services to passengers requiring wheelchair, bariatric, or stretcher accommodations. However, Applicant is explicitly restricted from operating more than three vehicles statewide and the aforementioned additional three vehicles point-to-point within Douglas and Sarpy counties for all other forms and methods of transportation services. Further, the transportation of passengers and their baggage originating from,

or point-to-point within, Adams, Buffalo, Hall, and Lincoln counties, by any form and method of transportation services, is not authorized.
