AFTER DUE INVESTIGATION, it is hereby certified that the above-named carrier has complied with all applicable provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. sections 75-301 to 75-322 and the requirements, rules and regulations prescribed thereunder and, therefore, is entitled to receive authority from the Nebraska Public Service Commission to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a motor carrier.

IT IS CERTIFIED that pursuant to the Commission's Order, the said carrier be, and is hereby, issued this Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as evidence of the authority of the holder to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a common carrier by motor vehicle; subject, however, to such terms, conditions and limitations as are now, or may hereafter be, attached to the exercise of the privileges granted to said carrier.

AND IT IS FURTHER CERTIFIED that the transportation service to be performed by the said carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce shall be as specified below:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: (1) Transportation of passengers by bus or van in Special Party and Charter service in and between points within Douglas, Sarpy, Lancaster, York, and Johnson counties, on the one hand, and on the other hand all points in Nebraska over irregular routes.

(2) Transportation by van or SUV in Open Class service in and between points within Douglas, Sarpy, Lancaster, York, and Johnson counties, on the one hand, and on the other hand all points in Nebraska over irregular routes.

Restrictions:

(1) The transportation of passengers funded through the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services is not authorized. This restriction includes, but is not limited to, the Division of Children and Family Services;

(2) Non-emergency medical transportation is not authorized;

(3) The transportation of passengers funded through the Nebraska Office of Probation Administration is not authorized; and

(4) Open Class service may only originate or terminate at Eppley Airfield, Omaha.
