O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On July 3, 2024, David Sankey, Director of the State 911 Department of the Nebraska Public Service Commission (“Department”) filed a complaint against Windstream Nebraska, Inc (“Windstream”), alleging Windstream operated in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-111, 75-133, and 75-156 and 291 Neb. Admin. Code §§ 5-002.02D, 5-002.02H, and 5-002.03A and requesting a hearing on those allegations.

On October 16, 2024, Windstream agreed to a stipulated agreement with the Department to resolve the allegations contained in the Complaint, and an order was entered dismissing the complaint. Since that time Windstream has submitted all required reports in a timely manner showing completion of the agreed upon terms to ensure continued compliance. Windstream has shown satisfactory completion of the requirements of the stipulated agreement.

For the reasons stated above, the Commission finds this docket should be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the above-captioned docket be, and is hereby, closed.
