Now comes the Nebraska Public Advocate, who operates under § 66-1831 Neb. Rev. Stat. (2018) which allows her to:

(b) Petition for relief, request, initiate, and intervene in any proceedings before the Commission concerning such utilities, except for tariffs subject to section 66-1868, and

(c) has the duty to represent and appear for ratepayers and the public in proceedings before the commission and in any negotiations or other measures to resolve disputes that give rise to such proceedings except for tariffs subject to section 66-1868. The Public Advocate respectfully requests to withdraw her formal intervention.

The Parties in the Docket NG-132 promptly and directly answered the questions posed regarding the encumbrance of property under 66-1827 and satisfied the inquiry and investigation of the Public Advocate. The Public Advocate requests that the intervention, questions and public answers be made part of the public record in this docket, and confidential answers be part of the sealed records.

Once the Commission finds, upon examining such documents and financing, that the application is reasonable and proper, in the public interest, and will not be detrimental to the interests of the ratepayers affected, the Commission should grant its permission for the proposed financing by written order and accept the withdrawal of this formal intervention.
