BY THE COMMISSION:

The Nebraska Public Service Commission (“Commission”), on its own motion, opened the above-captioned investigation for the purpose of gathering information regarding, and reviewing the administration of, customer choice programs for natural gas service offered within the State of Nebraska (“Choice program”).

Previously in this docket, the Commission has solicited written comments and held workshops regarding a range of topics primarily related to residential customers within the Choice program administered by Black Hills Nebraska Gas, LLC (“Black Hills”). The docket remains open for the purpose of continuing to gather information regarding the Choice program and reviewing its administration.

The Commission hereby schedules a workshop in the interest of continuing discussion regarding the Choice program and for the purpose of reviewing the 2026 Choice Gas Selection Period. In addition to its general review of the Choice program, the Commission will facilitate a discussion between Black Hills and Choice Gas Program Suppliers (“Suppliers”) related to the Fixed Monthly Bill (“FMB”) price options offered by certain Suppliers and the impacts of a General Rate filing by Black Hills in May of 2025 and a subsequent stipulation regarding issues raised by Suppliers in that proceeding.¹ Specifically workshop participants will be asked to discuss whether (1) the FMB price option should continue, and if permitted to do so, (2) whether a confidential prior notice of a rate proceeding by Black Hills Nebraska Gas, LLC should be given to each of the Choice Gas Suppliers.

The workshop shall be held on **Tuesday, June 30, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. Central Time.** The workshop will be held in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium

While the Commission is not soliciting written comments at this time, parties wishing to submit a comment may do so at least one week prior to the workshop. Written comments and supporting documentation regarding the 2026 Selection Period will be due to the Commission on or before **June 23, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. Central Time** in order to be considered as part of the workshop. These items, as well as any other filings in this docket, should be submitted electronically to psc.naturalgas@nebraska.gov.
