

PERMIT OF AUTHORITY TO OPERATE IN NEBRASKA

AFTER DUE INVESTIGATION, it is hereby certified that the above-named transportation network company has complied with all applicable provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. Sections 75-301 to 75-342 and the requirements, rules and regulations prescribed thereunder and, therefore, is entitled to receive authority from the Nebraska Public Service Commission to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a transportation network company.

IT IS CERTIFIED that, pursuant to the Commission's Order, the said transportation network company be, and it is hereby, issued this Permit of Authority to Operate in Nebraska as evidence of the authority of the holder to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a transportation network company by motor vehicle; subject, however, to such terms, conditions and limitations as are now, or may hereafter be, attached to the exercise of the privileges granted to the said transportation network company.

IT IS FURTHER CERTIFIED that the transportation network company is further authorized to provide Medicaid Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT) services pursuant to a contract with the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, a medicaid-managed care organization under contract with NDHHS, or another agent working on behalf of NDHHS. Said NEMT services are limited such that Lyft may only be used in the capacity as a recovery provider, in the event NDHHS, or its agent(s) working on its behalf, are unable to find a suitable non-transportation network company provider. The NEMT authorization granted herein is explicitly limited to only Medicaid Non-Emergency Transportation services provided through the NDHHS brokerage system, as defined under Neb. Admin. Code, Tit. 471, Ch. 27, § 002.11, and authorized under Neb. Rev. Stat. 75-342

AND IT IS FURTHER CERTIFIED that the transportation network company shall adhere to the statutes of Nebraska and the rules and regulations of the Nebraska Public Service Commission. Failure to do so will result in civil penalties up to and including revocation of this permit.
