AFTER DUE INVESTIGATION, it is hereby certified that the above-named carrier has complied with all applicable provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. sections 75-301 to 75-322 and the requirements, rules and regulations prescribed thereunder and, therefore, is entitled to receive authority from the Nebraska Public Service Commission to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a motor carrier.

IT IS CERTIFIED that pursuant to the Commission's Order, the said carrier be, and is hereby, issued this Permit of Authority as evidence of the authority of the holder to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a contract carrier by motor vehicle; subject, however, to such terms, conditions and limitations as are now, or may hereafter be, attached to the exercise of the privileges granted to said carrier.

AND IT IS FURTHER CERTIFIED that the transportation service to be performed by the said carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce shall be as specified below:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED: CONTRACT: Service by wheelchair accessible van in Open Class service in Lancaster, Seward, Butler, Saunders, Cass, Otoe, Gage, Saline, Douglas, Sarpy, Washington, and Dodge counties over irregular routes pursuant to a contract with the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, a medicaid-managed care organization under contract with NDHHS, or another agent working on behalf of NDHHS.

HHS Designation: Yes.

RESTRICTION: Applicant is restricted from operating more than one vehicle at any given time. Applicant is explicitly limited to providing wheelchair, stretcher, or bariatric transportation services, and may not utilize its vehicle for any other forms and methods of transportation services.
