AFTER DUE INVESTIGATION, it is hereby certified that the above-named carrier has complied with all applicable provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. sections 75-301 to 75-322 and the requirements, rules and regulations prescribed thereunder and, therefore, is entitled to receive authority from the Nebraska Public Service Commission to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a motor carrier.

IT IS CERTIFIED that pursuant to the Commission's Order, the said carrier be, and is hereby, issued this Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as evidence of the authority of the holder to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a common carrier by motor vehicle; subject, however, to such terms, conditions and limitations as are now, or may hereafter be, attached to the exercise of the privileges granted to said carrier.

AND IT IS FURTHER CERTIFIED that the transportation service to be performed by the said carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce shall be as specified below:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Service by sedan, van, and SUV in Open Class service in Cass, Douglas, Sarpy, Saunders, and Washington counties over irregular routes. HHS Designation: Yes.

RESTRICTION: Applicant is explicitly restricted from operating more than three ambulatory vehicles at any given time for all ambulatory forms and methods of transportation services. Nothing in this restriction shall prohibit Applicant from utilizing more than three vehicles for the purpose of providing standard wheelchair, bariatric wheelchair, power chair, bariatric power chair, bariatric transport, transport chair, rehab chair, stretcher or other similar specialized transportation services.
