The company does not apply data caps or speed throttling to its services and does not offer metered "pay-as-you-go" services. Additionally, the company is currently offering "price for life". 

While the FCC's 2024 urban rate survey benchmark for 100/20 Mbps service is \$92.24 as shown above and this is the amount we used in the application, the Q Fiber brand services we will be marketing do not currently include a 100/20Mbps service. The Q Fiber price offerings in this attachment F highlight that the current pricing for the proposed grant area is the same as most areas we serve nationally. Additionally, our current pricing for the lowest FTTP speed tier is significantly below the FCC's 2024 urban rate survey benchmark.

As the Q Fiber FTTP broadband service pricing can change over time, the company cannot commit to keeping our national price offerings for 5 years. However, CenturyLink QC agrees to keep a price at or below the FCC's 2024 urban rate survey benchmark for 100/20 Mbps service for the 5-year commitment period for our lowest tier speed service that meets or exceeds 100/20 Mbps.
