Attachment D – Noncontiguous Areas

Fillmore County grant would build fiber-to-the-home as a noncontiguous project. In 2021 Glenwood Telecommunications partnered with Fillmore County to fund and construct a broadband infrastructure project to serve 172 locations in rural Fillmore County building off Glenwood’s existing fiber network already serving Fillmore County rural homes and businesses. On February 1, 2022, Glenwood was awarded a 2021 NBBP grant to assist in building this project and has since been completed.

In 2023 Glenwood and Fillmore County partnered to continue expanding Glenwood’s fiber network to provide fiber broadband connectivity to another 57 unserved locations and to continue expanding the footprint into more rural locations in Fillmore County. On January 9, 2024, Glenwood was awarded a 2023 NBBP grant to assist in building this project and is currently completing construction.

Again in 2024 Glenwood and Fillmore County partnered to continue expanding Glenwood’s fiber network to provide fiber broadband connectivity to another 88 unserved locations and to continue expanding the footprint into the more rural locations in Fillmore County.

Glenwood’s Fillmore County 3 Project is made up of five noncontiguous areas that will connect to Glenwood’s existing fiber network. These areas are noncontiguous and within different exchanges, but have a natural connection to one another, all within Fillmore County. Glenwood respectfully ask that this application be considered as a single project.
