A reorganization or change of control requiring an application to the Commission includes any transaction which, regardless of the means by which it is accomplished, results in a change in the ownership of a majority of the voting capital stock of a jurisdictional utility and does not include a mortgage or pledge transaction entered into to secure a bona fide borrowing by the party granting the mortgage or making the pledge (Neb. Rev. Stat. § 66-1828(2)).

Applicants seeking approval of a transfer of control shall submit an original and eight (8) copies of the application to the Commission at the address below.

The application fee is required to cover the administrative costs of accepting and processing a filing. In addition, each Applicant may be assessed additional costs and expenses reasonably attributable to the application consistent with Neb. Rev. Stat. § 66-1840.

Applicants must notify the Commission during the pendency of the certification request of any material change in the representations and commitments required by this subsection within 14 days of such change.

DESCRIPTION OF TRANSACTION:

Pursuant to an Equity Purchase Agreement entered into on February 24, 2020, by and between CenterPoint Energy Resources Corp., a Delaware corporation ("CERC"), and Athena Energy Services Buyer, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("Athena"), Athena will acquire from CERC, upon receipt of all required approvals and consents, all of the membership interests in CenterPoint Energy Services, Inc. (CES"), a retail and wholesale supplier of natural gas and related services (the "Transaction"). Athena itself is a wholly-controlled indirect subsidiary of ECP Control Co, LLC ("ECP").

ANTICIPATED EFFECTIVE DATE OF TRANSACTION:

Approximately May 8, 2020

DESCRIBE WAYS IN WHICH PUBLIC INTEREST SERVED BY THE TRANSFER OF CONTROL:

The proposed Transaction benefits the public interest because ECP's investment in the CES will support CES's continued growth and allow CES to leverage ECP's extensive energy industry expertise. ECP is a private equity and credit investment firm with over \$19 billion in capital commitments. The firm focuses on investing in the traditional and renewable power generation, midstream oil and gas, electric transmission, environmental infrastructure and related energy services sectors of North America's energy infrastructure. CES will continue to serve its customers and operate in the State. The change in control will not negatively affect competition and CES will continue its operations in accordance with the requirements set forth in Neb. Admin. Code 291.9-011.04.
