MidAmerican Energy Services, LLC, Docket No. NG-0082

MidAmerican Energy Services, LLC ("MES") respectfully submits the enclosed Application to Withdraw Competitive Natural Gas Provider Authority and requests that the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") terminate MES's authority to operate as a competitive natural gas provider in Nebraska, to be effective as of the date of the Commission's approval.

On November 27, 2024, MES entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement with Constellation NewEnergy, Inc. Pursuant to that agreement, MES transferred all retail natural gas customers to Constellation and exited the retail natural gas supply business. MES has no active retail natural gas customers in Nebraska, no pending customer enrollments, no outstanding customer complaints, and no remaining retail natural gas supply obligations in the State. MES is not marketing, soliciting, or offering competitive natural gas services in Nebraska and does not intend to resume service under its existing authority. As of the date of this letter, MES has satisfied all applicable certification, reporting, and regulatory requirements.

Based on the foregoing facts, MES submits that withdrawal of its Nebraska competitive natural gas provider authority will not adversely affect customers, jurisdictional natural gas utilities, or market operations. The enclosed application provides the information requested by the Commission's withdrawal form, including MES's identifying information, certificate docket information, Nebraska customer count, and customer-notification information.

MES respectfully requests that the Commission approve the enclosed application and withdraw MES's competitive natural gas provider authority. MES will coordinate with the applicable natural gas utilities and other market participants regarding the termination of any remaining registrations or operating agreements and will comply with any additional notice, reporting, or administrative action the Commission or its Staff may require. The filing fee associated with this application will be sent under separate cover.
