Providing qualifying low-income Nebraskans with a monthly subsidy to keep telephone service affordable

What: A state-funded program to provide a \$3.50/month

subsidy to voice telephone service (landline or mobile)

in addition to federal subsidies through the Lifeline

Program

Eligibility: Income at our below 135% of the federal poverty

guidelines or participation in one of the following benefit

programs:

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

Medicaid

Federal Public Housing Assistance

Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit

Supplemental Security Income

To Apply: Apply for the federal Lifeline Program at

Federal Lifeline Program

Receive \$9.25 discount for your bundled voice and internet service or \$5.25 discount for voice only service

INDIVIDUAL ELIGIBILITY:

You qualify for a discount if:

- You participate in one of these programs:
 - Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
 - Medicaid
 - Federal Public Housing Assistance
 - Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit
 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Your income is at or below 135% of federal poverty guidelines

Only one Lifeline discount is allowed per household

TO APPLY:

Three ways to apply:

- Apply online at lifelinesupport.org
- Mail your application with proof of eligibility to: Lifeline Support Center PO BOX 9100 Wilkes-Barre, PA 18773
- Contact your phone or internet company

You many need to show proof that you qualify, such as:

- A copy of your SNAP or program letter
- A copy of your pay stub or tax return to prove you meet income eligibility
