

# Nebraska Telehealth Program (NUSF-57)

## *Enhancing Connectivity for Rural Healthcare Providers*

- What:** A state-funded program that offers supplemental funding for rural healthcare providers that also participate in the federal Healthcare Connect Fund (HCF), a subprogram of the FCC's Rural Healthcare Program (RHC). The state program covers up to 25% of eligible costs, supplementing the 65% discount provided by the federal HCF program.
- Eligibility:** Applicants in Nebraska must demonstrate participation in the federal HCF program. Individual rural healthcare providers or a consortium (with a majority of rural sites) can apply.
