The areas we are proposing to serve with funding from this grant are noncontiguous. Each of these three areas are located at point on or near our majority owner/parent’s planned “Middle Mile” fiber build, and as such; these locations will be served with fiber-based backhaul.

Should the NTIA Middle Mile grant not be won by Quick Current LLC, we are still able to serve these locations with either fiber-based backhaul and with DIA from alternative providers.

Each of these locations are near the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska’s tribal lands, and will be serving residents that are Tribal members of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska who live and work in these communities, as well as our neighbors. These areas are adjacent to Tribal lands and are part of our planned service areas where we have obtained licensed spectrum, and, we believe we can deliver superior service here as well.
