With that current monitor it was not able to automatically download to the John Deere Ops Center like the new monitors will be tied to do, therefore we were 98% full which starts to overload that type of monitor. It was hard to find flash drives to be able to hold all the data and with the new monitors, flash drives will be a thing of the past as the data will be directly transferred to our computers every thirty minutes.
