August 18, 2026

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Notice was duly published August 7, 2026, on page 6 of The Daily Record that the regular public meeting of the Commissioners of the Nebraska Public Service Commission would be held on August 18, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln.

Chair Tim Schram called the regularly scheduled meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. with Commissioners Christian Mirch, Eric Kamler, and Dan Watermeier present in the Commission Hearing Room, and Commissioner Kevin Stocker appearing virtually. Chair Schram stated that a copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act is posted in the meeting room and invited the public to address the Commission. No public comment offered. Chair Schram announced and welcomed Aaron Davis and Traci Christman to the Commission and congratulated Commissioner Dan Watermeier on his appointment as co-Chair on the NARUC Committee on Infrastructure.
