Rate comparability details

Nebraska Central Telephone Company (NCTC) is committed to offering a 100/100 Mbps plan to customers in the North Loup Village Limits Underserved Capital Project Fund grant project area for \$65.00. All customers in the project area will have access to the \$65.00 plan, regardless of whether they are NCTC telephone customers. The remaining available fiber plans in the project area are the same plans available to all NCTC customers and are listed below. Although NCTC does not like to raise rates and historically its parent company Hamilton Telecommunications is typically able to keep internet rates relatively stable, NCTC may raise its rates up to 10% per year if business conditions dictate. Again, NCTC's preference would be to not raise rates during the five-year period. NCTC's retail rate will not include data caps, throttling speeds after usage limits are reached, long-term contracts, early termination fees, or metered "pay-as-you-go" service.
