Rate comparability details

Nebraska Central Telephone Company (NCTC) does currently offer a 100/100 Mbps plan in locations where fiber is already deployed. NCTC is committed to offering that 100/100 Mbps tier of service at or below \$80.50. The cost of that 100/100 Mbps plan is currently \$119.95 per month. However, NCTC understands that the Public Service Commission (PSC) made a finding in Application No. C-5368 released on May 10, 2022, that an applicant must commit to offering 100/100 Mbps service at or below \$80.50 in the project area for at least five years after a project is completed to score the rate comparability points in Round 2 of the Broadband Bridge Act. It is clear to NCTC that the PSC believes that an awardee should strive to offer service to customers at or below that rate. NCTC agrees with that objective. As stated in the grant application, the planned rate for 100/100 Mbps service in the project area will be at or below \$80.50. Additionally, that retail rate will not include data caps, throttling speeds after usage limits are reached, long-term contracts, early termination fees, or metered "pay-as-you-go" service.
