

Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company (NNTC) hereby certifies that it will commit to fund 34.3% percent of the total project cost as proposed by Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company's *Bringing Fiber Fast Internet to Emerson* project. We hereby commit to funding of \$515,000.00. The village of Emerson has agreed to fund \$15,000.00. This proposal submitted by Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company is also contingent on Dixon County Supervisors approving \$220,000.00 of ARPA relief funding from the federal government for 10 miles of rural build to the village of Emerson. All together, these funding sources account for \$750,000.00 or 50% of the total project cost.
