LINCOLN, JANUARY 5, 2017— The Nebraska State Capitol was the site on Thursday, Jan. 5, for the swearing in of Public Service Commissioners Rod Johnson and Mary Ridder. The public inaugural ceremony held in the Legislative Chambers marked the beginning of a six-year term for both Commissioners.
