NEBRASKA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION TO HOLD WORKSHOP ON GIS

LINCOLN, APRIL 21, 2017— On Monday, May 1, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (PSC) will hold a workshop to examine and review funding, standards and policies relating to Geographic Information Systems (GIS) data necessary for the delivery of Next Generation 9-1-1 (NG9-1-1) service in Nebraska.

“Accurate, updated and seamless GIS data is essential to the successful integration of NG9-1-1 in our state,” said Dave Sankey, State 9-1-1 Director. “Hosting this workshop will provide opportunity for our partners from both the public and private sector to ask questions and gather detailed information on GIS as it relates to 9-1-1.”

The workshop will provide a means of better defining technical standards, policies, system requirements, and funding priorities relating to GIS data.

The GIS workshop will be held beginning at 10:00 a.m., Monday, May 1 in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, in Lincoln. A telephone bridge will be available for those unable to attend the workshop in person. The call-in number 888-820-1398, attendee code 5582059#.
