SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED: Transportation of passengers and their baggage by taxicab between points in Lincoln and a twenty-five (25) mile radius thereof, including, but not limited to, the communities of Crete, Firth, Garland, Greenwood, Hallam, Milford, Panama, Seward, and Wahoo, and between points in said area on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of passengers and their baggage originating outside of Lincoln and a twentyfive (25) mile radius thereof is not authorized, except for a continuation of a trip originating in Lincoln and a twenty-five (25) mile radius thereof, and return to a destination in Lincoln and a twenty-five (25) mile radius thereof and shown on the same billing document as a continuation of the originating trip.
