BY THE COMMISSION:

Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 88-541 (Reissue of 2014), the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") must, not less than once a year, fix reasonable storage rates for warehouse licensees.

Therefore, the Commission finds that a hearing on rates for Schedules "A" and "E" shall be held on May 20, 2020 at 1:00 p.m. CDT. This hearing will be held electronically in accordance with the Governor's Executive Order No. 20-03. As the meeting will be held electronically, and no quorum of the public body will be physically present together, there will be no public in-person attendance.
