BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On June 1, 2020, Black Hills Nebraska Gas, LLC, d/b/a Black Hills Energy ("Black Hills" or "Applicant") filed an application seeking a general rate increase. On July 13, 2020, the procedural schedule was set by order of the hearing officer.

The hearing in this matter was previously scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, October 26, 2020, in the Lancaster Ballroom of the Cornhusker Marriott Hotel. However, the parties to this proceeding have advised the Commission that they are in the process of finalizing a complete settlement of the issues. With the advice and consent of the parties, I therefore find that the hearing in this matter should begin at **1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 28, 2020**. I further find that the additional space afforded by the Cornhusker Marriott Hotel is no longer needed, and that the hearing should be held in the **Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska**.
