BY THE COMMISSION:

The Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission"), on its own motion, seeks to determine reasonable "A" and "E" storage rates and charges for Public Grain Warehouses for the 2021-2022 storage year. Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 88-541 (Reissue of 2014) Commission must, not less than once a year, fix reasonable storage rates for warehouse licensees.

Interested parties may file written comments with the Commission on or before **3:00 p.m. CDT on Wednesday, April 28, 2021**. Parties filing comments should file one (1) original and five (5) paper copies and one (1) electronic copy in Word format emailed to terri.fritz@nebraska.gov and Dillon.Keiffer-johnson@nebraska.gov.
