## BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 2, 2021, Black Hills Nebraska Gas, LLC d/b/a Black Hills Energy ("Black Hills") filed an application with the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") seeking approval of a System Safety and Integrity Rider to be effective on January 1, 2022. A Petition of Formal Intervention was filed by the Nebraska Public Advocate on August 10, 2021.
