BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On June 30, 2021, the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") opened the above-captioned docket to address an application filed by Black Hills Nebraska Gas, LLC d/b/a Black Hills Energy, of Rapid City, South Dakota, ("Black Hills") to modify its tariff. The proposed modification relates to costs incurred by customers electing to convert to its Energy Options program subsequent to the February cold weather event. Petitions of formal intervention were submitted by the Public Advocate and by WoodRiver Energy, LLC ("WoodRiver"), and were subsequently granted by order of the Hearing Officer on July 19th and August 5th respectively.

Procedural Schedule

After the submission of the application by Black Hills, a planning conference was held with the parties to this docket. This order serves to formalize the timeline for proceedings in this docket.

A. Service

B. Discovery

Parties should reference the Nebraska Court Rules of Discovery in Civil Cases for general guidance as to the conduct of discovery. Should this order conflict with any provision of said Rules, this order will control. Parties should make efforts to resolve any discovery disputes.

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All parties shall provide a courtesy copy of any discovery requests and responses to the Commission. Such discovery requests and responses shall not be part of the official record unless they are offered and accepted as exhibits during the hearing on the application. This conference will be held via webconference, and access instructions will be sent to the parties the week prior to the conference.

If no motions are submitted, and there are no other outstanding issues which must be considered prior to hearing, the Commission will notify the parties that the prehearing conference will be cancelled.

F. Hearing
