The Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission"), on its own motion, opened the above-captioned investigation for the purpose of gathering information regarding, and reviewing the administration of, customer choice programs for natural gas service offered within the State of Nebraska ("Choice programs").

Previously in this docket, the Commission has solicited written comments and held workshops regarding a range of topics primarily related to residential customers within the Choice program administered by Black Hills Nebraska Gas, LLC ("BHNG"). The docket remains open for the purpose of continuing to gather information regarding the Choice program and reviewing its administration.
