The purpose of this letter is to notify you, the NEBRASKA CPF applicant, of our intent to challenge the above mentioned NEBRASKA CPF project application. The reason for the anticipated challenge is as follows:

- We currently provide broadband network in the proposed project area with access to the Internet at speeds equal to or greater than one hundred megabits per second for downloading and twenty megabits per second for uploading (100/20 Mbps). Attached to this notice are details reflecting the specific area(s) in which we currently provide service at speeds equal to or greater than 100/20 Mbps.
- We are currently constructing broadband infrastructure within the project area or have broadband service proximate to the project area and we commit to complete broadband infrastructure deployment within the project area with access to the Internet at speeds equal to or greater than one hundred megabits per second for downloading and twenty megabits per second for uploading (100/20 Mbps), no later than eighteen months after the date grant awards are made under the program. Attached to this notice are details reflecting the specific area(s) that are proximate to the project area in which we currently provide service, as well as the area(s) in which we commit to complete construction of broadband infrastructure at speeds equal to or greater than 100/20 Mbps.
